1.4.3 Organizing training or programs to improve access to basic services for all

Our results of the Research and Innovation for Personalize Poverty Alleviation in Phatthalung Province in the the "Lenoi Craft" community enterprise, which was designed to help vulnerable groups create financially and socially sustainable businesses, is the learning center of the local people. This support enabled the development of new skills and higher-quality products, increasing the market value of the items produced and thereby boosting the incomes of the participants. Furthermore, the project involved extensive skill-development programs covering crafting techniques, marketing, and business management, which empowered the community members to improve their own livelihoods. Additionally, by coordinating with local agencies to provide home repairs and support for the elderly and disabled, the project enhanced access to essential services and ensured support for those in the community facing the greatest hardships.
