6.5.4 Utilization of sustainable water extraction technologies on associated university grounds on and off campus

Thaksin University has a surface water source used for producing sufficient tap water for consumption in ponds that contain 340,736 square meters. Thaksin University has reserve water storage tanks in buildings for consumption. Thaksin University has a wastewater treatment system in its buildings. It has been treated before being dumped into the water surrounding the building. Thaksin University has conservation activities including:

- 1. Using water-saving sanitary ware
- 2. Creating awareness of economical water use
- 3. Check and maintain the water pipe system regularly. to reduce water loss
- 4. Random collection of samples for water quality analysis
- 5. Maintenance of the wastewater treatment system
