


Report on SDG1: No Poverty Thaksin University, Thailand

1.3.4 Programs or initiatives to assist students who fall into the bottom 20% of household income group (or a more tightly defined target) in the country to successfully complete their studies

As mentioned previously, it is possible for some students from low-income families to not receive allocated scholarships. Thaksin University (TSU) has never overlooked this issue. TSU therefore provides employment scholarships, allowing students to work in various university departments and accumulate working hours to receive a support fund of 10,000 Baht per person. In the academic year 2023, there were 60 students who received this scholarship, totaling 600,000 baht in support funds.
